- 5. Are there any third parties involved in this project?
- $\mathbf{6}$ . Will you be moving out whilst the refurbishment is commencing?
- 7. Do you want to do the house in phases or all at once?

### What's next?

1. After completing this questionnaire you should create a brief by collating all of your answers. You can do this by making a section for each room and cutting and pasting all of your answers on a particular room into that room's section.

2. After this, it's time to get plans of the house. You may have AutoCAD plans, you may have plans from the estate agent you bought the property from (if it's a recent purchase) or you may have to draw them yourself. It's important to have some sort of scalable plans so that later you can play around with any furniture or large furnishings you're considering. It's also helpful to have a general overview of the space in your house when you're thinking about the interior design.

3. On the plans, draw in where all of your lighting and electrics are. You will then know where you have electrics to work with or where you will have to make a new installation.

4. Always keep the brief in the back of your mind while you are creating the design. I start by thinking about the overall space and any theme or style that may unite the property. Then I like to think about the colour and wall finishes, followed by the floor, after which I go room-by-room, considering the look for each room and what will go in it.

Having a good brief allows you to take into consideration the needs of all those who live in the property, so you can create a beautiful, harmonious and well-designed home.
